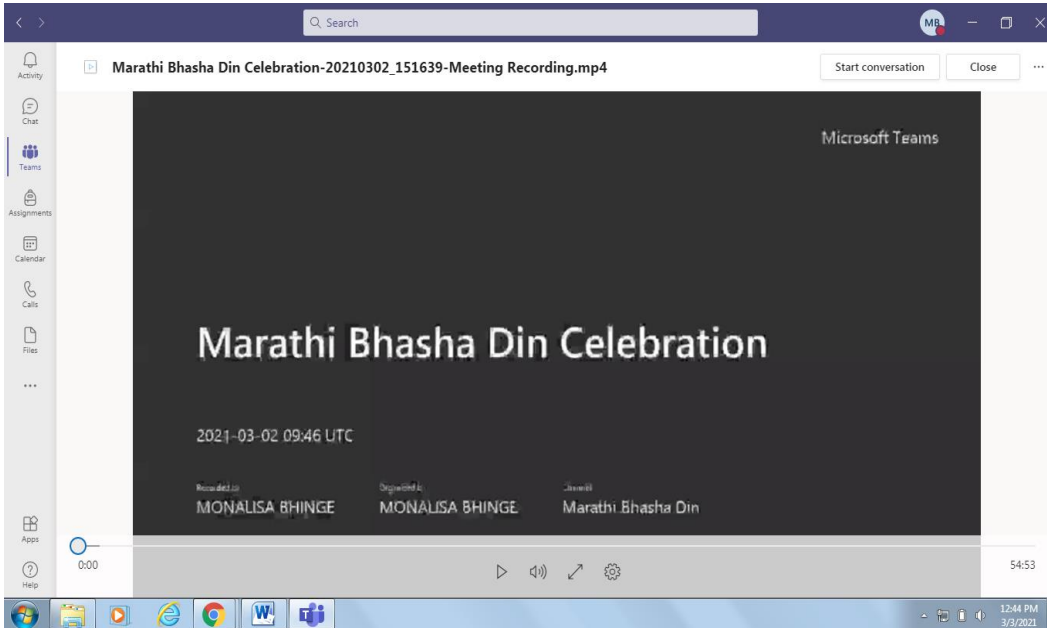
Marathi Bhasha Diwas

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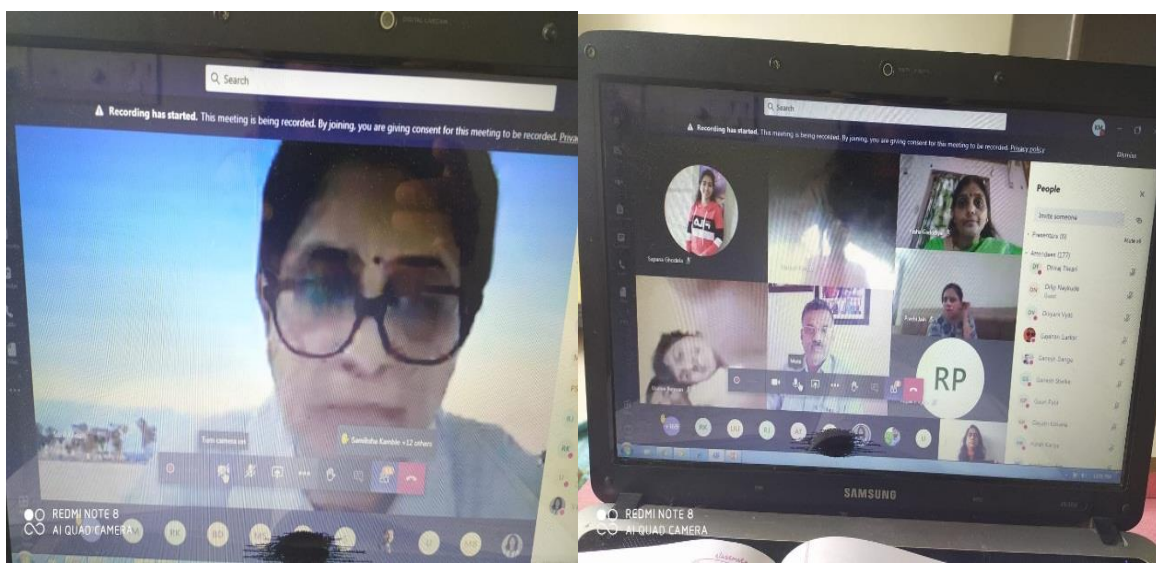
Online Parent Meet

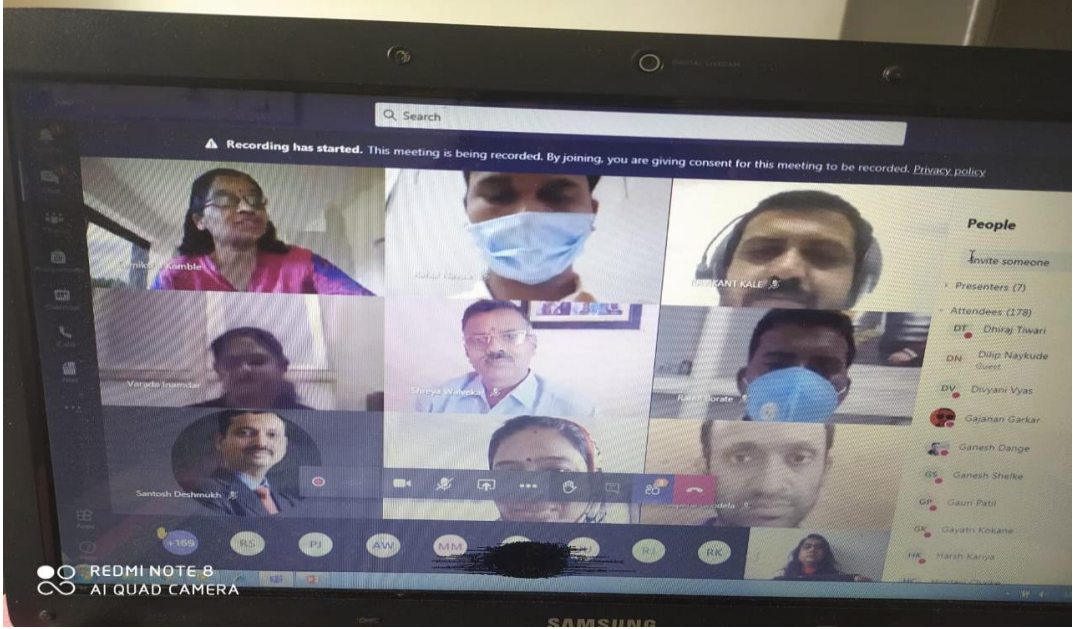

Webinar on Intellectual Property Rights

A one-day online webinar was organized by Sinhgad institute of management on “Intellectual Property Rights” - “Protect Your Properties, Protect Your Ideas” under IIC by Guest Speaker Ms. Archana Joshi, Lead, IP Facilitation Center at Venture Center.

Intellectual property right (IPR) is the rights granted to the creators of intellectual property and include trademarks, copyrights, patent, industrial design rights and some jurisdictions and trade secrets. Rather than protecting possessions, intellectual property law protects exclusive rights to use or reproduce the intellectual property (IP). Copyrights protect expression while patents protect inventions and neither protects ideas.

The technical session started with an excellent and interactive presentation on the “Copyright Systems in India” by Archana Joshi. Ms. Archana is a Registered Patent Agent at Indian Patent office. Ms. Archana started by explaining the importance of IPR in the present scenario. The history of copyright, followed by the different types and the dual role played by copyrights were discussed. The talk gave a clear idea about the different rights granted by copyright such as the economic and moral rights, about right of paternity and right of integrity which comes under the moral rights. The seminar on IPR created great awareness among students, research scholars and faculty of Sinhgad institute of management about the important concepts related to IPR, copyrights and patent issues.

A online session via YouTube on “Why IP is important in academia? “ by Dr. Abhay Jere, Chief Innovation Officer, MoE’s Innovation Cell and Dr. Mohit Gambhir, Innovation Director, MoE’s Innovation Cell was organized by SIOM on 26th April 2021.

Intellectual property refers to the protection of creation of mind which has both a moral and a commercial value. Intellectual property rights are the rights given to the persons over the creation of their mind: usually give the creator an exclusive right over the use of his/her creations for a certain period of time. The effective and enforceable system for protection of IPR promotes the innovation in science by promoting strong incentives to authors and innovators to create intellectual assets. During this session the following points were discussed: Introduction of Intellectual Property Rights, Copyrights, Trademark, and Patents, What things can be patented (e.g. Inventions, parts, processes etc.)? , Where do we apply Trademark and Copyrights?, Procedure of IPR Registration, Registration authorities, Complete specifications required for patenting, etc. , Concept of Generic Geographic Indication, Trade Secret, WORLD INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ORGANISATION and Strategies for protection and exploitation of IPR for startups. The lecture was full of knowledge as most of the students were unaware of many concepts. The session concluded with an interactive question & answer session.

Lecture series on Wellness for Wellbeing

Lecture series on “Wellness for Wellbeing” organized by Sinhgad Institute of Management, Pune on 23rd May 2020. The lecture series was organized online through WebEx software. Saurabh Sahay, Business consultant, Executive & Life Coach and Mentor, explained how to stay away from COVID-19 mentally and physically. Understanding how the COVID-19 pandemic and measures to prevent the virus' transmission affect our mental health can help us adapt; From focusing on everyday boosts to mental health to empowering our communities, these expert recommendations can help. Improving our mental health hygiene now could help us create a “new normal” for mental well-being in the future. He has discussed how can we boost our mental health in the COVID-19 era to minimize the impact of the virus and the “social distancing” in our lives, and to develop a healthier and more resilient “new normal” for the future? Will we finally pay serious attention to the link between stress regulation and our health and well-being?

Dr. Pallavi Kasande (Mohadikar), Founder, MindGym Consulting, discussed about how to overcoming the fear of future, dealing with uncertainty during the Coronavirus Pandemic. The current COVID-19 pandemic has heightened uncertainty over the economy, employment, finances, relationships, and of course, physical and mental health. Yet as human beings, we crave security. We want to feel safe and have a sense of control over our lives and well-being. Fear and uncertainty can leave you feeling stressed, anxious, and powerless over the direction of your life. It can drain you emotionally and trap you in a downward spiral of endless “what-ifs” and worst-case scenarios about what tomorrow may bring.
