Battle of Pratapgad Fort: It was the first significant victory. The murky plot by Adil Shahi general Afzal Khan was given a befitting reply by Raje and his army. He was aware about the peace negotiation offered by Afzal Khan was mere an eyewash to kill him. Maharaj with his alertness, intelligence, effective leadership and guerrilla warfare tactics planned the events. He armed himself and put his army in dense forest and hilly areas of Pratapgad to block the escape route for enemy soldiers. One of the best qualities of a leader is to keep right person for right job at right time. Raje took Jiva Mahal with him knowing his skills and work before joining army. At the same time, when Sayyad Banda tried to attack Raje, Jiva Mahal responded quickly with Danpatta, killing Banda and saving life of Raje.

When Raje and his son were under house arrest in Agra for almost three months. Aurangzeb had a plan to weaken Raje mentally and physically and then kill them. 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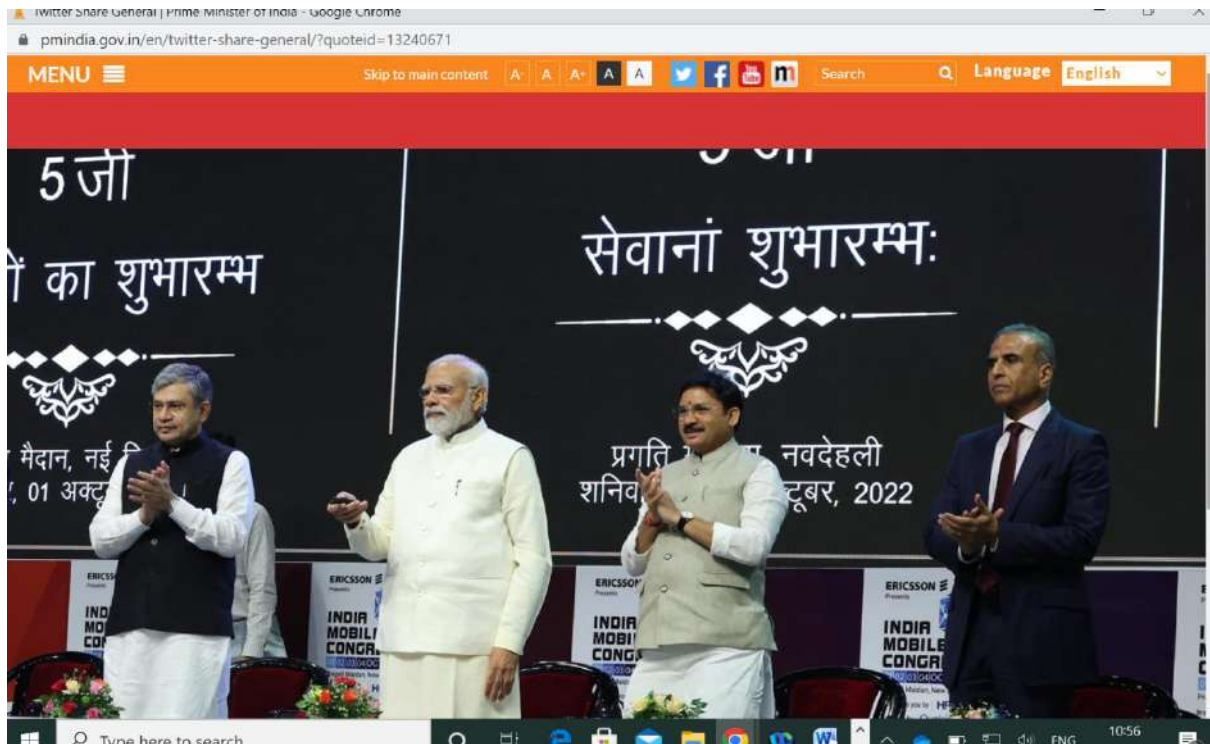

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We have attended the function online through

Ushering in a new technological era, the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched 5G services in Pragati Maidan, New Delhi today. The Prime Minister also inaugurated the sixth edition of the India Mobile Congress and also witnessed the IMC Exhibition that was put on the occasion.

Industry leaders expressed their views on this historic occasion.

Shri Mukesh Ambani, Chairman, Reliance, thanked the Prime Minister for inspiring the vision of a developed nation by 2047. "Every action and policy of the government is skillfully crafted to propel India, towards that goal. Steps taken to fast-track India's march into the 5G era provide compelling proof of our Prime Minister's determination", he said. He narrated the possibilities of 5G in key areas like education, education and climate etc. "Your leadership has raised India's prestige, profile and power globally like never before. In today's fast-changing world there will be no stopping a resurgent India from soaring to the top", Shri Ambani concluded.

Shri Sunil Bharti Mittal, Chairman, Bharti Enterprise remarked that the launch of 5G is the beginning of a new era and since it is happening during Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, it makes it even more special. "With the efforts of the Prime Minister, this will usher new energy in the country. We are fortunate to have a leader in the Prime Minister who understands technology very minutely and deployed that to the

development of the country in an unmatched manner”, he added. Shri Mittal further said that it will open up a sea of opportunities for people, especially in our rural areas. He recalled the Prime Minister’s initiatives in the field of infrastructure and technology from his Gujarat CM days. He said that during the pandemic, traffic shifted to villages and homes and the country’s heartbeat did not stop even for a second. Credit for that goes to the digital vision. He also praised the audacity and achievement of the vision of Make in India. “Along with Digital India, the Prime Minister also took forward the Start-up India campaign and soon enough, India started producing unicorns”, Shri Mittal added, “With the advent of 5G, I’m sure that the country will add many more unicorns in the world.”

Shri Kumar Mangalam Birla, Chairman, Aditya Birla Group called the advent of 5G a transformational event that proves India’s prowess on the global stage and reiterates the role of telecom technology as the bedrock of India’s growth. He thanked the Hon’ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi for his vision and leadership for a generational leap in technology that has resulted in India making a mark on the global stage. He also thanked the Prime Minister for his inspirational role in supporting the telecom industry during the ongoing pandemic and for the path-breaking telecom reforms in the industry. Shri Birla said that the launch of 5G marks the beginning of an exciting journey for India. “We will see limitless potential for 5G development and use cases in the years to come”, he added.

The three major telecom operators of the country demonstrated one use case each in front of the Prime Minister to show the potential of 5G technology in India.

Reliance Jio connected a teacher from a school in Mumbai, with students in three different locations in Maharashtra, Gujarat and Odisha. This demonstrated how 5G will facilitate education by bringing teachers closer to students, obviating the physical distance between them. It also demonstrated the power of Augmented Reality (AR) on screen and how that is being used to teach children across the country, remotely, without the need for an AR device. The Prime Minister interacted with students from Dnyanjyoti Savitribai Phule School, Raigad, Maharashtra in presence of Maharashtra Chief Minister, Shri Eknath Shinde. Students from Ropda Primary School, Gandhinagar, Gujarat connected in presence of Gujarat Chief Minister, Shri Bhupendra Patel. The Prime Minister also interacted with students from SLS Memorial School, Myurbhanj, Odisha in presence of Odisha Chief Minister, Shri Navin Patnaik. Shri Abhimanyu Basu, Dhirubhai Ambani Int. School, BKC, Mumbai also demonstrated the use of 5G technology. The Prime Minister noted the enthusiasm of the students for technology in education. Author Amish Tripathi introduced the segment.

The Vodafone Idea test case demonstrated the safety of workers in an under-construction tunnel of Delhi Metro through the creation of a Digital Twin of the tunnel on the dias. Digital Twin will help give safety alerts to workers in real time from a remote location. PM took a live demo from the dias to monitor the work in real-time through utilising VR and Artificial Intelligence. The Prime Minister interacted with Shri Rinku Kumar, a worker in Delhi Metro Tunnel Dwarka, New Delhi in presence of Delhi Lieutenant Governor, Shri Vinai Saxena. The Prime Minister inquired about the user experience and learning curve needed to adopt the technology. He said that

workers' confidence in safety is the biggest contribution of new tech. He complimented the workers of India for their contribution to the nation's growth.

In the Airtel demo, students from Dankaur, Uttar Pradesh witnessed a lively and immersive education experience to learn about the solar system with the help of Virtual reality and Augmented reality. A student Khushi, shared her experience of learning with the PM by appearing on the dias through a hologram. Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister, Shri Yogi Adityanath connected from Rudraksh Convention Centre, Varanasi. The Prime Minister inquired if the VR education experience helped them understand the concepts in a comprehensive way. The student said that after this experience she is much more inclined toward learning new things.

Addressing the gathering the Prime Minister said that the Summit today might be global but its repercussions and directions are local. He said today is a special day for the fast-developing India of the 21st century. "Today, 130 crore Indians are getting a wonderful gift in the form of 5G from the country and from the telecom industry of the country. 5G is a knock on the doors of a new era in the country. "5G is the beginning of an infinite sky of opportunities. I congratulate every Indian for this.", he added. He noted with satisfaction that in this launch of 5G and the march of technology, rural areas and workers are equal partners.

Stressing one more message of the 5G launch, the Prime Minister said "New India will not remain a mere consumer of technology, but India will play an active role in the development and implementation of that technology. India will play a big role in designing the future wireless technology, and manufacturing related to it." The Prime Minister pointed out that India was dependent on other countries for 2G, 3G and 4G technologies. But with 5G, India has created a new history. "With 5G, India is setting a global standard in telecom technology for the first time", he remarked.

Talking about Digital India, the Prime Minister said that some people think that this is just a government scheme. "But Digital India is not just a name, it is a big vision for the development of the country. The goal of this vision is to bring that technology to the common people, which works for the people, works by connecting with the people."

Focussing on the need for a holistic approach to Digital India, the Prime Minister elaborated that "we focused on 4 Pillars, in four directions at once. First, the price of the device, Second, digital connectivity, Third, the cost of data, Fourth, and most importantly, the idea of 'digital first' .

Regarding the first pillar, the Prime Minister said that the low cost of devices can only be achieved through Aatmnirbharta. The Prime Minister recalled that there were only two mobile manufacturing units in India till eight years ago. "These numbers have now gone up to 200", Shri Modi said. The Prime Minister underlined that from exporting zero mobile phones in 2014, today we have become a mobile phone exporting country worth thousands of crores. "Naturally, all these efforts have had an impact on the cost of the device. Now we have started getting more features at a lower cost", he added.

On the second pillar of digital connectivity, the Prime Minister informed that internet users have increased to 80 crores from 6 crores in 2014. From less than 100 panchayats in 2014 now 1.7 lakh panchayats are connected by optical fiber. "Just as the government started a door-to-door campaign to provide electricity, worked on the

mission of providing clean water to everyone through the Har Ghar Jal Abhiyan, and delivered gas cylinders to the poorest of the poorest people through the Ujjwala scheme, our Government is working in a similar manner on the goal of Internet for all”, he said.

Regarding the third pillar, the cost of data, the Prime Minister said that the industry was given a slew of incentives and technologies like 4G received policy support. This brought down the price of data and a data revolution was ushered in the country. These three pillars started showing their multiplier effect everywhere, he said.

On the topic of the fourth pillar i.e. Idea of ‘Digital First’, the Prime Minister recalled the time when a handful of the elite class questioned if the poor would even understand the meaning of digital and doubted their potential, the Prime Minister said that he always had faith in the understanding, wisdom and inquisitive mind of the common man of the country. He said that he always found the poor of the country ready to adopt new technologies.

Highlighting the government’s efforts in the field of digital payments, the Prime Minister remarked that it was the government that went ahead and made the way for digital payments easier. “The government itself promoted citizen-centric delivery service through the app. Whether it is about farmers or small shopkeepers, we have given them a way to meet their daily needs through the app”, Shri Modi added. He recounted the seamless continuation of DBT, education, vaccination and health services, and work-from-home during the pandemic when many countries were finding it difficult to keep these services going.

Remarking that Digital India has given a platform, the Prime Minister said that small traders, small entrepreneurs, local artists and artisans can now market to everyone. Shri Modi added, “Today you go to a local market or vegetable market and see, even a small street vendor will tell you, not to transact in cash, but via ‘UPI’.” “This shows”, the Prime Minister added, “When a facility is available, thinking also gets emboldened”. The Prime Minister said when the government works with clean intentions, the intentions of citizens also undergo change. “This is the key difference in the intention (niyat) of 2G and 5G”, he remarked.

The Prime Minister said that the cost of data is among the lowest in the world. It has come down from 300 rupees per GB to about 10 rupees per GB. Remarking on the consumer-centric focussed efforts of the government, the Prime Minister said that the cost of data in India has remained very low due. The Prime Minister interjected, “It is a different matter that we did not make a fuss about, and did not launch big advertisements. We focused on how the convenience and Ease of Living of the people of the country increased.” “India may not have benefitted from the first three industrial revolutions, but I am confident that India will take full benefit of the 4th industrial revolution and, in fact, will lead it”, he added.

The Prime Minister informed that the use of 5G technology will not be limited to speedy internet access, but it has the capability to change lives. He said that we will see the promises of the technology realized in our lifetimes. Shri Modi urged the leaders of the telecom industry association to visit the schools and colleges of the country and unleash every aspect of this new technology. He also asked them to create an enabling ecosystem for MSMEs to prepare spare parts for electronic manufacturing. “5G technology should be used to bring about a revolution in the

country”, he remarked. The Prime Minister highlighted the use of drone technology that has been made possible after the newly launched Drone Policy. He pointed out that many farmers have learnt how to fly drones and started making use of them to spray insecticides and pesticides in the fields. The Prime Minister assured one and all that India of the future will guide the world in the upcoming technology sector, in turn making India a global leader.

Union Minister of Communications, Shri Ashvini Vaishnav, Union Minister of State for Communications, Shri Devusinh Chauhan, Chairman of Reliance Industries, Shri Mukesh Ambani, Chairman of Bharti Enterprises, Shri Sunil Mittal, Chairman of Aditya Birla Group, Shri Kumar Mangalam Birla and Secretary, Department of Telecommunications, Shri K Rajaraman were those present on the occasion.

Background

5G technology will offer a wide range of benefits to the common people. It will help in providing seamless coverage, high data rate, low latency, and highly reliable communications. Also, It will increase energy efficiency, spectrum efficiency and network efficiency. 5G technology will help in connecting billions of Internet of Things devices, will allow higher quality video services with mobility at high speed, and delivery of critical services such as telesurgery and autonomous cars among others. 5G will help in real-time monitoring of disasters, precision agriculture, and minimising the role of humans in dangerous industrial operations such as in deep mines, offshore activities etc. Unlike existing mobile communication networks, 5G networks will allow tailoring of requirements for each of these different use cases within the same network

The IMC 2022 is scheduled to be held from 1st to 4th October with the theme of “New digital Universe”. And Corporate Office Plot-C -713 B, First Floor, Sector-7 (Market), Dwarka, New Delhi 110077. India, of the **FIRST PARTY**;

AND

**Sinhgad Institute of Management (SIOM)**, Pune, Maharashtra. S. No. 44/1, Vadgaon (Bk), Off Sinhgad Road, Pune-411041

**WHEREAS** Veterans India is a National apolitical patriotic non-profitable organization of Veterans from all fields led by an Ex-Servicemen (which includes Gallantry Awardees, Martyr's families, Disabled Soldiers, Ex-Servicemen and their families) to inculcate patriotism, nationalism and integrity among citizens of the Nation especially youth and students.

**AND WHEREAS** the parties, through professional interactions and collaboration seek to bring patriotism, nationalism and integrity in students of higher education Institutions ( HEIs) of India by merging veterans experience and guidance through higher education activities, both enter into this agreement to establish a strategic partnership in the areas given in more details in the succeeding paragraphs.

### **Preamble and Objectives**

The objective of this MOU defines standards for the overall development of UG and PG students by bringing a Military touch that enables the youth to grow in all three dimensions (Mansa, Vacha and Karmana).

### **Strategic Collaboration (Objectives, Scope & Outcome)**

The Veterans India and (Name of College) under this MOU, shall collaborate towards:

1. Bringing nationalism and patriotism in higher education Institutions (HEIs)/Universities through activities based on veterans India themes and sharing experiences of Ex-Servicemen.



2. Personality development and Strategy building practices within higher education Institutions / Universities by involving local Veterans within higher education Institutions/ University vicinity.
3. Targeted preparation for SSB/CDS and other military examinations and interviews.
4. Modernizing NCC culture in higher education Institutions/ University vicinity by quick adoption model.
5. Connecting youth with veterans to make 2nd innings of veterans a better place full of knowledge and joy.
6. Adoption of Must Train method [Strategy and Tactics] for self-defense and national security.
7. Working together for the welfare of Gallantry Awardees, Martyr's families, Disabled Soldiers, Ex-Servicemen and their families.
8. Weekly/Monthly Activities to bring veterans from India and retired Military personnel into Induction level programs in higher education Institutions/Universities.
9. Monetary Compensation to Veterans for sessions they attend as speakers or expert to share their experience post-retirement.
10. All Sports/ physical fitness activities are to be conducted in collaboration with the Veterans India Youth Wing to meet the objective of the FIT India movement launched by the Honourable Prime Minister.
11. The college / Institute/ University shall provide premises in their campus free of cost and available manpower to Veterans India for patriotic activities as and when required besides above mention activities.
12. Facilitation of appropriate internship opportunities to the students in all applicable aspects of the organization including management and technology sectors in their Wings.

### Definitive Agreement



Any cost associated with the execution of the objectives of this MOU, if any, shall be mutually discussed and agreed to between the parties in a definitive agreement, before carrying out the activity.

### **Tenure and Termination**

This MOU is valid for five (5) years initially and will be deemed renewed for three years unless terminated otherwise.

This MOU shall commence as set forth above and remain in effect through the end of the term unless:

- a. Otherwise superseded by another agreement between the parties.
- b. The parties mutually agree to terminate this MOU.
- c. Either party gives the other 90 days' written notice of their intent to terminate this MOU.
- d. A breaching party has failed to cure a material breach of this MOU within 30 days following written notice of that breach given by the non-breaching party.

Each party is an independent contractor and no provision of this MOU grants either party any express or implied right or authority to assume or create any obligations or responsibility on behalf of or in the name of the other party or bind the other party in any manner or thing whatsoever.

Neither party shall assign or transfer the privileges and obligations under this MOU without the prior written consent of the other party.

The law of the Republic of India shall govern this MOU. Any dispute between the parties arising in connection with the performance of this MOU shall be resolved amicably between the parties through a process of negotiation



before the use of any judicial remedy before the appropriate forum. Both parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at New Delhi, for any action or proceeding.

Any changes to the MOU are to be mutually agreed to by Veterans India and the (Name of College/Institute/University) and executed in writing.

This MOU may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which will be deemed to be an original of this MOU and all of which, when taken together, will be deemed to constitute the same agreement. A signed copy of this MOU delivered by facsimile, e-mail or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of the original signed agreement.

# Eye Checkup Camp Organized By Green Cell

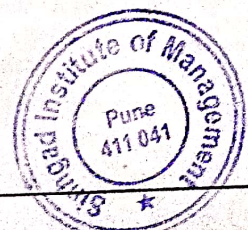
Eye Check-up Camp

Where Laws are meant for Justice and equality for everyone and the constitution who gives power to those rights and laws, which makes it applicable to every person or citizen of the country, brings the serenity. Thus, in country like India-world biggest democratic nation with wide demographic differences, it becomes necessary to learn and understand human rights, judiciary system and the constitution of a country, to protect and secure democracy.

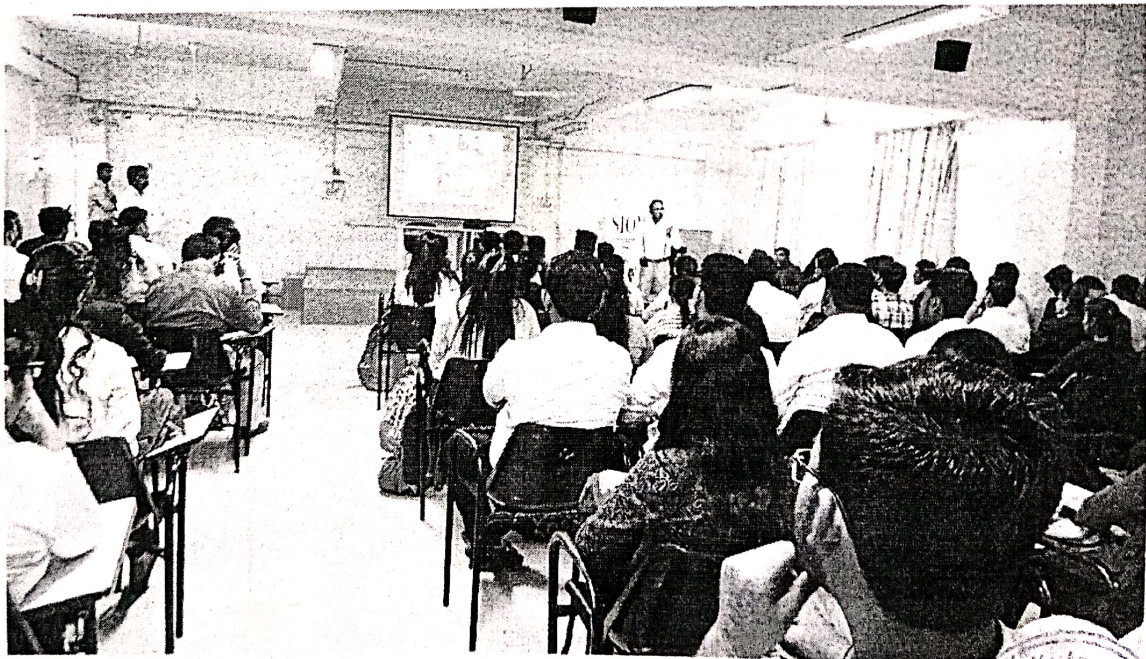


A two day workshop on Human Rights, Indian Judiciary system and The Constitution of India was organized for the students of Master of Business Management Ist Year batch 2022-2024 on 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2023, at Sinhgad Institute of Management.

### Day 1

The day 1<sup>st</sup> of the workshop began with the introduction of the resource person Mr. Manoj Wagh, Director of Tech Trainers and Testers, Pune, in association with National Service Scheme (NSS), by Miss Mahima Mangle and Miss Radhika Pawar. At the start of the workshop, printed study booklets on Human Rights, Indian Judiciary system and The Constitution of India was provided to the students by Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir.

He started the workshop in an interactive mode by asking the students about the Human Rights, What do they know about the Human Rights and What is the importance of Human Rights in India. 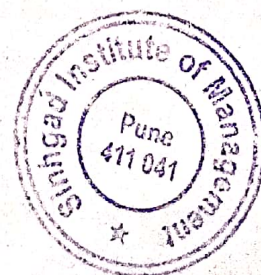

He discussed about the different fundamental duties and fundamental duties of a citizen; which they have to perform, what happens if they are not performed in a good manner? He also discussed about the Rights of the Students, Rights of the Employees, Women Rights, Right to Education and Right to Information, Right of the Consumers, Rights of the Companies along with its importance for the nation.

Further, Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir, discussed about the Judiciary System of India, which acts as a guardian and protects the rights of every human being in the country and how every human being can enjoy his or her own right because of the system. The working of the Indian Judiciary System, how does an aggrieved person can approach to the system for justice, raise voice against injustice in India was also discussed with the students. Along with it different mechanism to get the justice through Courts, specially Supreme Court and High Court and how the judiciary system does taking different steps to protect the rights of the human with ensuring that all people should get their rights and justice, ensuring the no violation of any right of the person. He discussed about Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993 – An act to provide for the constitution of a National Human Rights Commission, State Human Rights Commission and Human Rights Courts for better protection of human rights and for matters connected with them.

The resource person further took the session speaking about how does the Indian Judiciary System plays an important role for ensuring better public governance. There are number of laws, rules and regulations which a person has to follow while performing his duty.

At the end of the Day 1 of the workshop students received the immense and vital knowledge about the Human Rights and how does Indian Judiciary System guards them and guarantee's citizen of the country that they can enjoy their freedom of rights. On Day 2, session started with warm welcome of the resource person and the students and brief revision of the previous day's learning on Human Rights and Judiciary system by Miss Mahima Mangle and Miss Radhika Pawar.

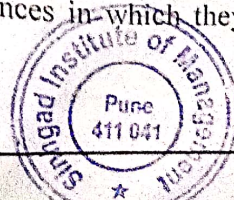
Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir, took the session further ahead by thanking to both the anchors and spoke in brief about last day's session. He started further speaking about the Indian Judiciary System.

The judiciary system which takes care and protects the fundamental rights of people also helps in resolving disputes, carrying major political decision and importantly ensuring the Constitution at Supreme and all the decisions according to it. The resource person speaks about the crimes and penalties, consequences of not following the duties in proper manner, punishments on hating, discriminating any person by his gender-religion-cast and others etc. also for not anyone letting enjoy his rights and performing his duties.

Further, Wagh Sir, discussed about the code of conduct, core values related to human rights and how judiciary system is stand there. He also spoke about judiciary systems of different countries like, America, Britain and few from Middle East, what are the core differences between the judiciary laws, rules and regulations along with comparing to India? How does the system works in those respective countries.

Later, Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir started discussing about The Constitution of India. He first asked students; do they know about the India's Constitution and what exactly they know about the same. The different Articles provided in Constitution of India, Which articles provides what kind of rights to the citizens of the country; the different circumstances in which they can utilize



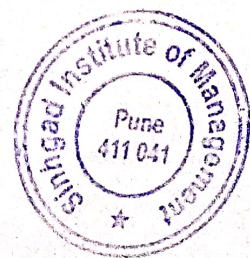
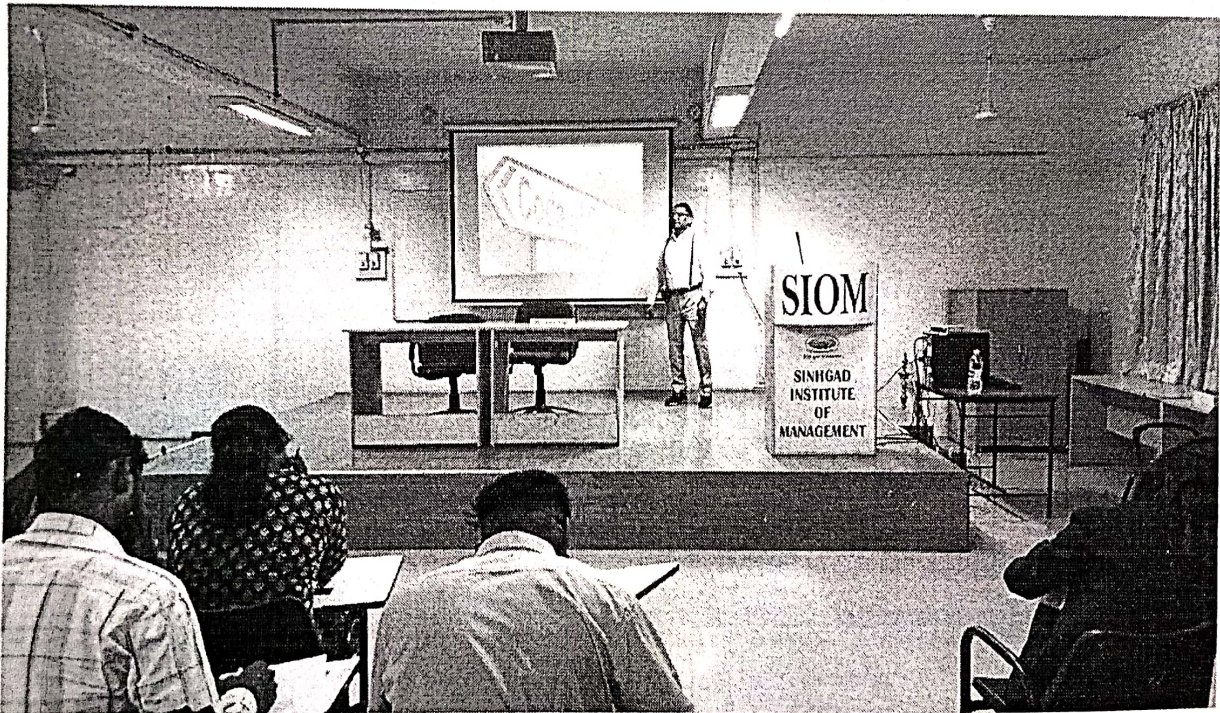
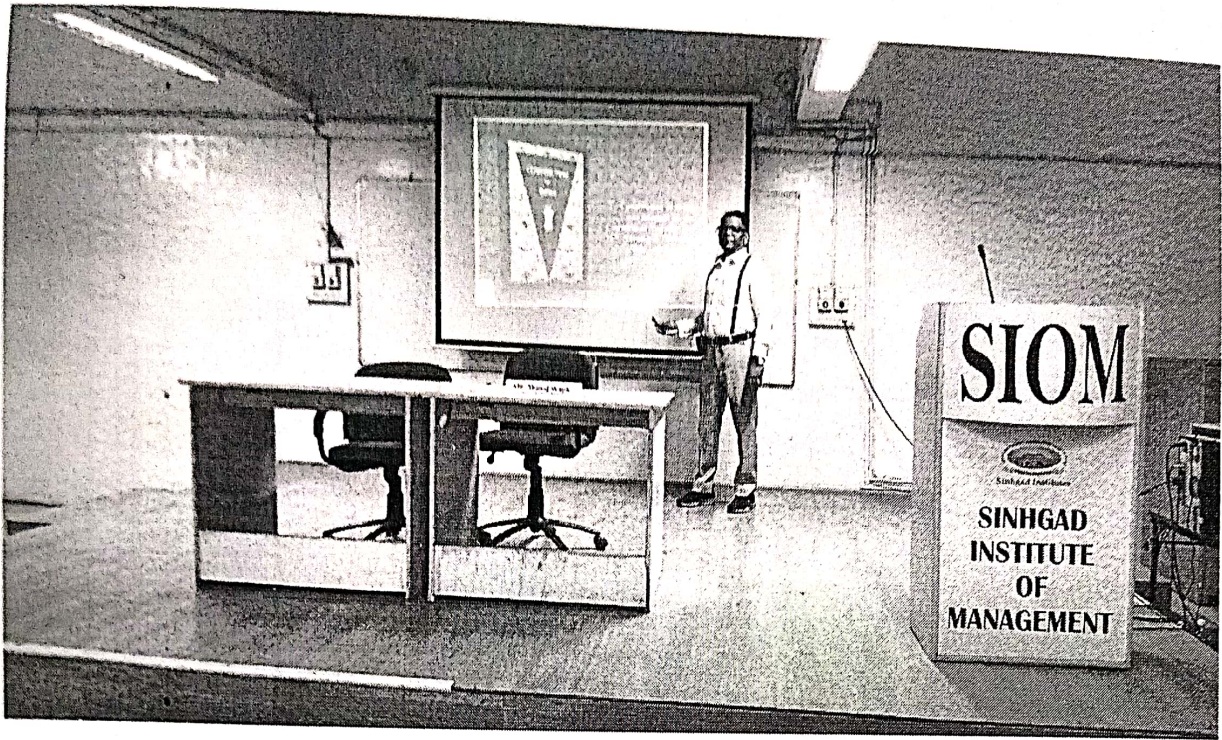

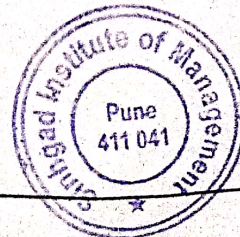
## **MARATHI BHASHA DIWAS**

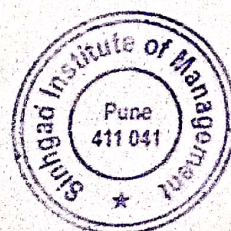
