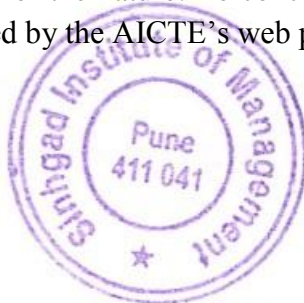

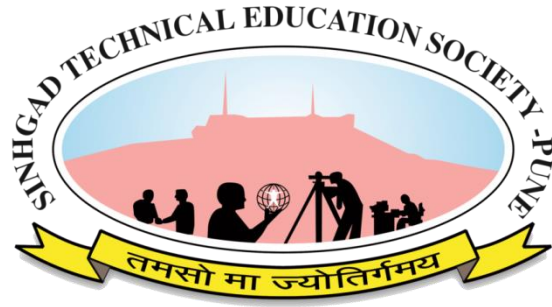

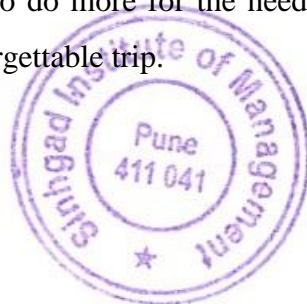

Description of activity in brief with photographs:

Marketing Division B students, SIOM, Pune had organized the debate competition to celebrate Gandhi Jayanti on 1st October, 2019 on the topics of "Gandhian Thoughts".

The competition began by addressing the audience and explaining the importance of Gandhian thoughts for the development of Indian society. Total 11 teams from different departments participated in debate competition and shared their views. There were 3 members in each team. 3 judges were invited for taking fair decisions. The judges invited were the faculty members from SIOM- Dr. Hemant Patil, Dr. Rijwan Shaikh and Prof. Archana Patil.

The participants were briefed with rules of the competition in the beginning. There were total three rounds of the competition. 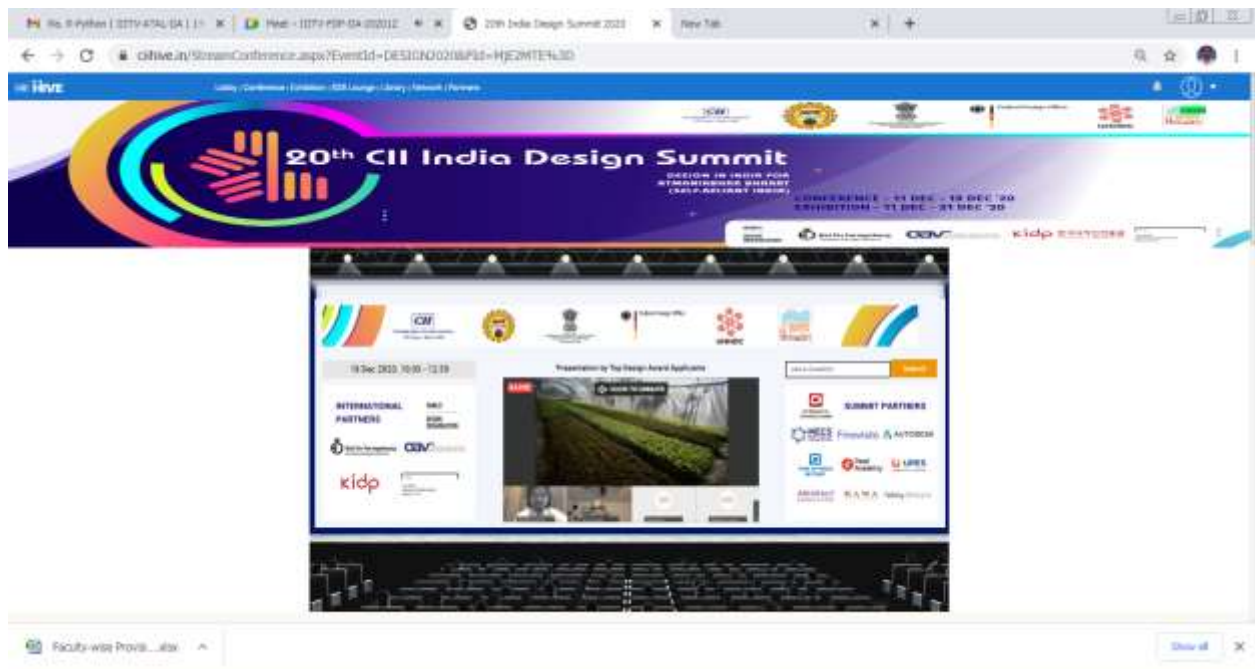
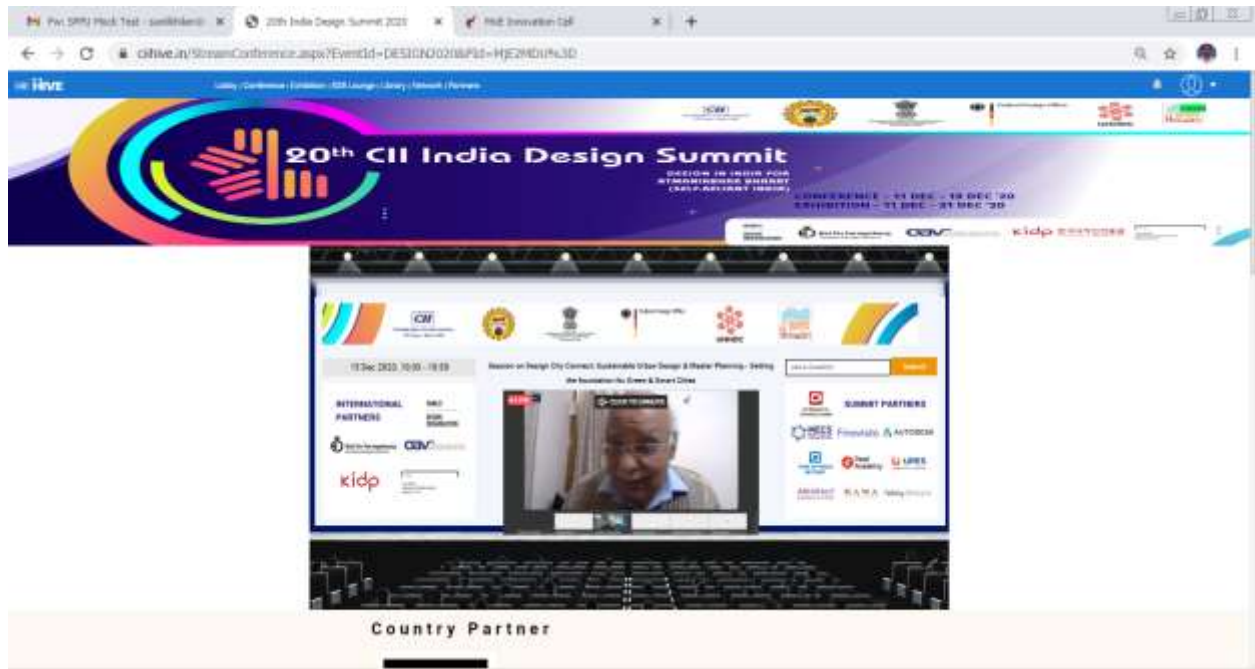

Session Theme - Design for Clean and Sustainable Cooking services

Partner – Modern Energy Cooking Services (MECS) Programme

As per, World Bank report “The State of Access to Modern Energy Cooking Service”, globally 4 billion lack the access to Clean Cooking, resulting in an economic opportunity cost of US\$2.4 trillion. Existing strategies are struggling to solve the problem of unsustainable, unhealthy but enduring cooking practices which places a particular burden on women. After decades of investments in improving biomass cooking, focused largely on increasing the efficiency of biomass use in domestic stoves, the technologies developed have had limited impact on development outcomes.

In India, considerable effort has been made towards development of Improved cookstoves, providing LPG access to over 80million households under the PMYU Programme are prominent. India has already achieved the status of electricity surplus nation in September 2020, however have very negligible reliance of Electric Cooking. Electricity is Affordable and Available and it being used as Cooking Energy is Convenient, Safe and Emission free. Further, using Electricity as cooking fuel can help reduce India’s Import burden for LPG. There are available clean cooking devices and systems to be developed that can work in weak grid or off-grid contexts. The fact that this then generates a much-needed additional load and potential revenue stream for energy providers, as well as the potential to demonstrate and release funds as a result of the substantial carbon emission reductions, means that the barriers to households securing eCooking devices can also be massively reduced. India’s world class manufacturing, technology and research base, clearly stands to benefit economically from the foreign and domestic need for clean cooking solutions, and position itself as a global clean cooking manufacturing hub.

The session aims to bring together Clean Cooking Device Manufacturers, Researchers, DISCOMs, Policy Makers, Funding Agencies and other Agencies to develop sustainable and clean cooking solutions to help India make a radical and sustainable shift towards Clean Cooking. Further, the session also explores opportunities for Indian Device Manufactures to enable the shift to Clean Cooking Globally.
