'Fiscal and Monetary policy in Theory and Practice During COVID-19' event was hosted on 16th December, 2022 by Sinhgad Institute of Management Vadgaon, Pune. The session started with the welcome note and a brief introduction of the guest of the session Dr. Anita Medhekar, Senior Lecturer in Economics at CQ University, Australia.

The speaker started the session with some general ideas and introduction about Macroeconomic policies i.e Fiscal and Monetary policies and what were its effects during and after COVID-19 impact including recent events such as Ukraine war. Later she talked about how cash payments were more used by federal Government of Australia, which was designed to stimulate consumer spending and how some cash payments were used to pay debts during the deficit budget in 2008-2009. Talking about growth rate of 3.5% during covid-19, she said "If your neighbours do well, you will do well" and that's how we overcame covid-19. She further talks about Australian Government's response to covid-19 and the household support, temporary reduction in rates/taxes provided. Dr. Anita madam discussed about some important

important points and insights about Australia and India's GDP growth rates, unemployment, inflation and their effects.

Dr. Anita madam gave significant knowledge about macro-economic policies – fiscal policies, their types, explaining Expansionary and Contractionary fiscal policies, what will happen if there were no such policies and its effects in long run as well as short run. With some points she further discussed Government purchase multiplier, Problems associated with fiscal policies effectiveness, Government spending reduce private spending.

She also briefed about how deficits, surpluses and federal government debts affect GDP with the help of some questions-

- Should the central budget always be balanced?
- Is government debt & deficit a problem?
- Can debt & deficits be a burden?

She also briefed about how monetary policies were monitored by Australia's Reserve Bank and RBA's roles and functions.

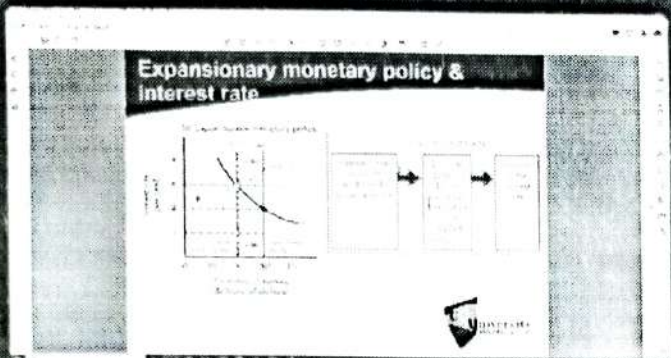
At the end of the session, she shared few questions on monetary policies-

- How the RBA manages Financial Liquidity and interest rates?

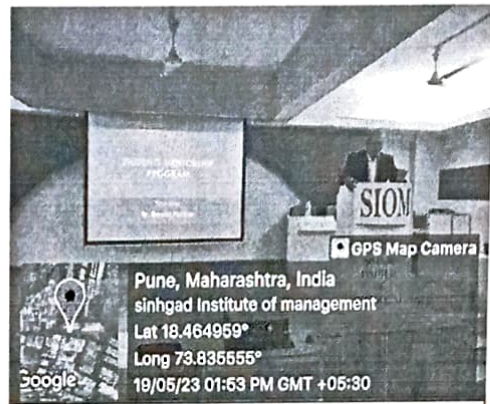

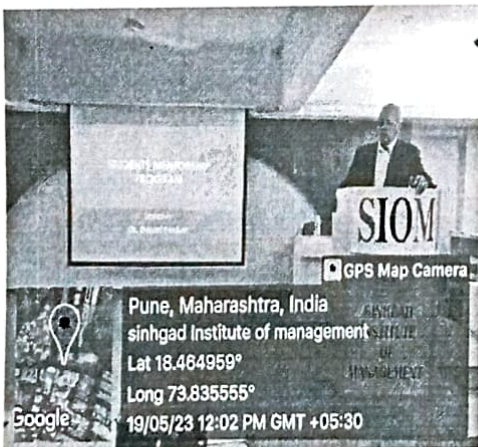

Dr. Shriram Dawkhari Sir felicitated Dr. Daniel Penkar Sir. Penkar Sir's Academic Journey has a rich experience of 37 years. Session started with sentence 'There are no failures it's only learning. If something doesn't happen as per one's expectation, believe that it's only learning.

He emphasized that students are here for transformation and this is a joint process. He gave a beautiful example of research during the second world war, which was done by psychologist Victor Frankl where he saw in a torture camp out of 100 people only 5 survived. He focused his research on those 5 people and concluded that the mental framework of these 5 was very strong which was the only cause for their continued existence. He was also one of them to survive the torture camp. Later Victor Frankl gave the phenomena that if one's mind is strong one can overcome any odds.

Further he highlighted few basic disciplines, having an agenda to do something daily is important and whatever one does give 100 percent to that work.

Sir also explained the principle of **FLASH**, proposed by Anand Kulkarni

H - Help

Sir explained the each and every concept of FLASH with different examples. He also told students that when we fail as a team or individual we have to take the ownership but when we succeed as team credit should be given to the rest of members which was accompanied by some real life examples of APJ Abdul kalam , Lal Bahadur Shastri , Mushe Dayal , Taj Hotels 26/11 they all have taken ownership was they failed

To explain Victory has many fathers and failure is orphan sir took a very recent example of Rishi Sunak How every country is claiming him as his son or son-in –law after he became Prime minister of UK

Sir gave a mantra to apply in our life is wherever we work be value to organisation not cost to organisation updating your things can be an asset for you
Working with old information does not work with dynamic environment

Sir explained about VUCA concept which basically is Volatile, Uncertain, Complex , Adversity but this changing time sir changed the meaning and it became Vision, Understanding , Clarity ,Agility

Sir gave a beautiful example of bumble bee to explain the concept of ignorance is bliss . A Bumble bee is not aware that her feather is too small to fly when compared to her weight but because she can not see that she can fly .






