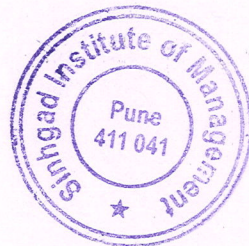

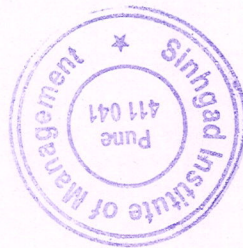

4. All class coordinators and mentors are instructed to have periodical discussions with the students in order to understand, if there are any issues that need to be addressed.





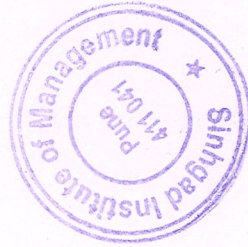
